AND LOAN ASSOCIATION All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about 2-1/2 miles west of Greenville Courthouse, near the Easley Bridge Road, being a portion of lots Nos. 20 and 22 of Block C, on plat of property of Julia D. Charles recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, page 209. Beginning at a stake on the southeast corner of Texas Avenue and Gordon Street, and running thence with Gordon Street and running thence with Gordon Street N. 71 E. 75 feet to stake, corner of lot sold to Mrs. H.K.
