SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, the said *S. A. Russell*,
in and by *S. A. Russell* certain *July 11th 1924* note, in writing, of
even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to

S. A. Russell
in the full and just sum of *\$1,000.00* One Thousand Eight
Dollars, to be paid *July 11th 1924* Fifty four Dollars per year after
date and the remainder two years after date

with interest thereon from *July 11th 1924* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *£1.00 (16%) per cent.* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference
being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *S. A. Russell*, his heirs and assigns

all that certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying
and being in the County and State aforesaid about two
and one half miles from Greenville County Court house
and having the following notes and boundaries to wit:
according to a plat made by Garrett and Hill beginning
at a stone pine tree on the east side of Old White Horse
Road and running thence $2^{\circ} 7' 6''$ $10^{\circ} E.$ 533.3 feet across
a spring branch, to another pine tree thence $97^{\circ} 20' 45''$ $N.$ 461. feet
to another pine tree corner street or road thence $97^{\circ} 8' 15''$
 $11^{\circ} 30' 6.8$ feet to another pine tree on Old White Horse Road
thence along Old White Horse Road $3^{\circ} 9' 30''$ $W.$ 350 feet to
the beginning corner and containing 3.6 acres more
or less and being the lot of land conveyed Jan. 12-1923
