NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Ed Rosemond

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Peoples National Bank, of Greenville, South Carolina, Executor of the Estate of D.D. Davenport, deceased

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 4.8 acres, conveyed to Ed. Rosemond by

Wiley Walker and John Walker by deed dated January 6, 1908, recorded in Book WWW, page 347. Also that other tract of land in Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 9-2 acres, more or less, lying on the South side of the White Horse Road, adjoining lands of Alfred Walker, Mrs. McWhite and others, being lot No. 5 of the division of the tract of 114 acres of the Willis Benson Estate, being the same conveyed to Ed Rosemond by Warren Rosemond by deed dated March 21, 1898, recorded in Book EEE, page 738. Also that other tract in Township, County and State aforesaid, adjoining the above described tract, fronting on White Horse Road, containing nine acres, more or less, being part of the same conveyed to Ed.
