NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, F.D. Fowler

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better

securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note. And also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and

released, and by these presents do bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of Conestee

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Gantt

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Being an undivided one-third interest in the land owned

by my deceased wife, Mrs. M.A. Fowler at the time of her death and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: - beginning on an iron pin in the road (Hampton's X), thence along road S. 5 E. 1/2 50 to an iron pin in road; thence N. 70 W. 1.52 to a stake on the Company's line; thence along Company's line N. 20 W. 3.16 to the beginning and containing one-fifth of an acre, more or less. The aforesaid lot is situated near Conestee Mills on the road leading from said Mill to Standing Springs Church, and is the same lot of land conveyed to my deceased wife, Mrs. M.A. Fowler by H.R. Scalf by deed dated June 25, 1907 and recorded in the Office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Vol. VVV, page 337.
