WHEREAS, I, H.K. Johnson

Dollars, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date herewith, due and payable on the 25th, August 1926

at the rate of seven per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually, and when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, H.K. Johnson

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the record whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell and release unto the Pioneer Life Insurance Company

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Ward One of the City of Greenville on the south side

of West Park Avenue, described as follows: Beginning at a point 528 feet from the southwest corner of the intersection of Townes Street and West Park Avenue, on the south side of West Park Avenue, and running thence with West Park Avenue N. 75-30 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 13-30 W. 80 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 40-30 E. 35 feet, more or less, to a point on the north side of a large white oak; thence S. 2-30 E. 40 feet, more or less, to a point in middle of branch; thence along said branch in an easterly direction 18 feet, more or less to an iron pin; thence N. 3-30 E. 40 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner on West Park Avenue.
