beginning at the West End of the City of Greenville, on the north side of Wilkins street, containing 2 6/100 of an acre, more or less, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone 3 1/2 N on Wilkins street and running thence N. 6 E. 3.61 chains to a peach tree 3 1/2 N; thence S. 68 links to a stone 3 1/2 N; thence S. 7 W. 3.77 to a stone 3 1/2 N; thence E. 70 links to the beginning corner, the same fully described by a plat made by W.
