I, Ola Porcher McNab SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, Ola Porcher McNab
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, W.D. Bishop well and truly indebted to

W.D. Bishop
in the full and just sum of Two hundred
Dollars, to be paid March 10th, 1923

with interest thereon from March 10th, 1923 date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10 per cent of amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Ola Porcher McNab
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.D. Bishop, his heirs and assigns, all those certain

lots of land lying and being just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville
and being known and designated as lots numbers twenty (20) and twenty-one (21) of a
subdivision known as Hicks and Jackson's subdivision according to a plat thereof by
R.E. Dalton, June 1920 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book
"E", page 258.

This being the said lot or lots of land conveyed to me by J.L. Willis by deed dated
July 7th, 1922 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book
75, page 199.

This is a second mortgage and is junior to a first mortgage for \$2000.00.
