computed and paid annually

paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Five per centum besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Hattie O. Smith

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Roy L. Smith and his assigns.

All that certain lot or tract of land in Butler Township County and state aforesaid, containing thirty nine and 8/100 acres more or less bounded by lands of Talley Watson, U.P. Hudson W. H. Watson and others, being about five and one half miles from the city of Greenville and being the same tract of land sold and conveyed to me by Perry W. Smith by deed bearing date of Oct. 31st. 1919 and recorded in the R. M. C. office in Vol. 73 at page 429 and being the same land conveyed to Perry W. Smith by Alvin H. Dearie by deed dated Nov. 19th 1904 and containing fifty two acres more or less, less twelve and 7/100 acres sold and conveyed therefrom by Perry W. Smith by deed dated 4th day of Dec. 1912 to Talley Watson, said deed being recorded in R. M. C. office in Book 1526 at page 194, this leaving 39 and 8/100 acres conveyed to me by Perry W. Smith by his deed above referred to for full description of said land.
