SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *J. J. Prewett*, the said *Promisor*  
in and by *One* certain *Promissary* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *me* well and truly indebted to

*T.H. Reid*  
in the full and just sum of *One Hundred*  
Dollars, to be paid *One Note 30th*

with interest thereon, from *Date hereof Dec 1923* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *monthly*

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose the mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Three Dollars*  
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under the mortgage) in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *J. J. Prewett*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *T.H. Reid*  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said *J. J. Prewett*  
in hand well and truly paid by the said *T.H. Reid*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *T.H. Reid*, All that certain parcel and tract of land

situate and being in the said State and County, on the North side of Middle Tyger River  
and bounded by lands of T.H. Reid on the North, and by lands of J.W. Tinsley on the west,  
said River on the south and by lands of T.E. Morrow on the east, and having the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit:  
Beginning at a stone on the Old Road, and running thence N. 48 W. 45.70 a P.O. (gone);  
thence S. 60 W. 25.50 to a stone on the River; thence down said River S. 55 E. 4.00; thence  
thence S. 25 E. 6.00; thence S. 82 E. 7.50; thence N. 75 E. 3.00; thence S. 85 E. 3.50;  
thence S. 60 E. 11.50; thence S. 50 E. 2.50; thence S. 70 E. 10.00; thence S. 55 E. 5.50,  
to corner in old Ford of Rutherford Road in said River; thence up the old abandoned Road  
N. 80 E. 11.00 to the beginning corner, and containing eighty acres, more or less, being
