with interest thereon, from Feb. 10, 1923 at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jas. M. Richardson, All that certain lot of land in the County

and State aforesaid, on Beverly Road, near Paris Station, with the following metes and bounds:
Beginning at a point on Beverly Road, joint corner of lots Nos. 10 and 11 as shown on
original plat recorded in R.M.C. Office in Plat Book C, page 121, and running thence along
said Beverly Road S. 78.39 E. 213.4 feet to point in road; thence along said road S. 74 E.
10.5 feet to corner in road; thence leaving said road and running N. 24.48 E. 577 feet to
corner; thence N. 65.12 W. 216 feet to corner of lots No. 10 and 11 according to original
plat above referred to; thence S. 24.48 W. 629.8 feet to the beginning, this being designated
as Lot No. 1 on a new plat this day made by C.M. Furman, Eng., which is to be recorded, and
