grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *R. D. Bates* and assigns, the

following property, to-wit: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and City and County of Greenville,
in the second Ward of said City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 6, in the plat
and survey of the lands of which Martin J. Howell died seized and possessed, made by W.A. Adams,
Surveyor, on the 10th, day of March, 1914 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County
in Plat Book C, page 155, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds,
to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the Spartanburg Road, corner lot No. 6, and running thence N. 11 E.
ninety-four (94) feet to a stake, corner lot No. 8; thence N. 35-1/4 W. 254 feet passing through
center of well to a stake in middle of Creek; thence S. 39-1/4 W. 83-1/4 W. 83-1/2 feet to stake
corner lot 3; thence S. 80-1/2 E. 23 feet to a stake on bank of creek; thence S. 80-1/2 E. 290
