thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Duncan to an iron pin on Hubert St. thence East with said Street 50 feet to the beginning
corner, being part of the tract of land deeded to me by H.W. Childs by deed dated 11th
