at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas F. Parker, all that certain lot or parcel of land, situate in Ward 2, of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning in the west line of Toy Street 200 ft. from the corner of East Washington Road and Toy Street, the northeast corner of Lot #13, runs thence with the line of lot #13, S. 75-0 W. 138.2 ft. to an alley, the corner of lot #13, thence with the alley N. 13-15 W. 55 feet to the corner of lot #15; thence with the line of said lot N. 75-0 E. 136.5 ft. to Toy Street, corner of lot #15, thence with Toy Street S. 15-0 E. 55 ft. to the beginning, said lot being #14 on a plat of the property of Thomas F. Parker, surveyed February 1916, and revised July 1916, April 1919 and January 1922 by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "E", page 115, the said lot having been deeded to me this day by Thomas F. Parker and being subject to the restrictions mentioned in the said deed.
