at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas F. Parker, all that certain lot or parcel of land, situate in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a point in the West line of Toy Street, 255 ft. from the corner of E. Washington Road and Toy Street, the Northeast corner of lot #14, runs thence with the line of lot #14 S. 75-0 W. 136.5 ft. to an alley, the corner of lot #14; thence with the alley N. 13-15 W. 55 ft. to a corner of lot #16; thence with the line of said lot N. 75-0 E. 134.8 ft. to Toy Street, the corner of lot #16; thence with the line of Toy Street, S. 15-0 E. 55 ft. to the beginning, said lot being #15 on a plat of the property of Thomas F.
