beginning at a stake on the North side of said National
Highway and running along the said Highway 50
feet to a stake; thence 150 feet to a stake, thence 50
feet to a stake, thence 150 feet to the beginning corner,
known as lot number 64 on Plat of W. A. Adams, dated
April 22nd, 1913 and recorded in Plat Book C. at Page 74.
This being the same lot of land conveyed to W. F.
