bargain, sell and release unto the said Southern States Lumber Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns forever, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid and being known and designated as Lot No. 8 on a plat of a survey of the Crescent Terrace property, by R.E.-Dalton, C.E., and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book "E", at page 137, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Tindal Ave., joint corner of Lots #7 and #8 and running thence S. 0-53 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of lot #19; thence N. 89-07 E. 67 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot #18; thence N. 0-53 W. 200 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots #8 and #9; thence S. 89-07 W. 67 feet to the beginning, and being the same lot conveyed to W.E.
