WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Fifteen hundred and no/100 Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land known and designated as Lot No. 8 of Block "P" of the subdivision known as Highland Terrace, as is shown by plat of said property made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, August 1917, and recorded in Plat Book E, page 101, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds, as follows:

Beginning at a point on Hill Crest Drive corner lots Nos. 8 and 9, and running thence N. 19-47 E. to an iron pin on a 15 foot alley; thence along said Alley 61.5 feet to corner of lot No. 7; thence along and with line of lot No. 7, S. 23-30 W. 190 feet to a point on Hill Crest Drive; thence along and with said Hill Crest Drive 50 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to me by Holmes B. Springs, deed recorded Volume 87, page 340.

Also, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land known and designated as Lot No. 9 of Block P, of the sub-division known as Highland Terrace as is shown by plat of said property made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, August 1917, and recorded Plat Book E., page 101 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin intersection of corners of Hill Crest Drive and Walter Street and running thence N. 16-32 E. 190 feet to an iron pin on a 15 foot alley; thence along and with said alley 61.3 feet to corner of lot No. 8; thence along line of lot No. 8, S. 19-47 W. to a point of Hill Crest Drive; thence along and with said Hill Crest Drive 50 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to me by J. Henry Madden, deed recorded Vol. 87, page 98.
