Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows to-wit:

In Greenville Township, near the Augusta Road School on the south side of Argonne Drive and being known and designated as lot 29 of the C.B. Martin Subdivision, as shown on a plat of record in Plat Book F, page 102 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pin, joint corner of lots 28 and 29 and running thence S. 48-50 W. 180 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 28, 29, 38 and 39; thence S. 41-10 E. 71 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 29, 30, 37 and 38; thence N. 48-50 E. 180 feet to an iron pin on Argonne Drive, joint corner of lots 29 and 30; thence N. 41-10 W. 71 feet to the point of beginning, being the same lot conveyed to B.M.
