with interest from *maturity* at the rate of *eight* per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid... annually, and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I... have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note... be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

Charles as Trustee for Estate of J. L. Quinn* all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in...

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, *Acquaintance* lot No. 73... are revised plat of property... state of J. Rawley Bacon... Engineer, July, 1928... according to said plat: Beginning *at the corner of Welcome Road, and running thence with Welcome Road N. 50-52 E. 27.5 feet to an iron pipe on new cut Dunham's Bridge Road, and running thence with new cut Dunham's Bridge Road N. 15-36 E. 457.6 feet to stake near the intersection of said new cut Dunham's Bridge Road and Casky Bridge Road; thence in a curve with the said 15-foot length to Casky Bridge Road N. 65 E. 291.7 feet to the beginning.*
