WHEREAS, I, the said Fannie C. Simpson in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to

G. L. Walker in the full and just sum of Sixteen Hundred + Fifty Dollars, to be paid May 3rd 1924

with interest thereon, from January 1st 1923 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said G. L. Walker

That that piece parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid, about three miles from Greenville Court House, on the West side of the Augusta Road and known and designated as Lot # 11 on a plat of a survey made by A. C. Dalton, C. E. August 1922, and described as follows:

Beginning on the West side of the Augusta Road a distance of 315.4 feet and running S. 56.12 W. along said McKee Spring Road and ending at an iron pin, thence S. 126.31 E. 61 feet to a corner of the intersection of the McKee Spring Road and the Augusta Road thence N. 62.27 E. 61 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot # 10, Mrs. M. M. Herd's lot thence N. 62.27 E. 61 feet to an iron pin on the Augusta Road thence N. 30.52 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
