Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$150.00 due and payable Dec. 1, 1923; \$150.00 due and payable
June 1, 1924; \$150.00 due and payable Dec. 1, 1924

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said M.W. Jones and Crystal Alton Williams All that piece,

parcels or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
and being known and designated as Lot No. 4, according to a plat of property of M.W.-
Jones and Crystal Alton Williams, made April 1923, by R.E. Dalton, C.E., and having
according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the North side of Crystal Avenue, joint corner of Lots Nos. 4
and 5 and being Three hundred and forty (340) feet from the intersection of Crystal
Avenue and Old Augusta Road, and running thence along joint line of lots 4 and 5, N. 29.18
W. two hundred (200) feet to a stake; thence N. 60.42 E. seventy-five (75) feet to a
stake at joint corner of lots 3 and 4; thence along joint line of lots 3 and 4, S. 29.18
E. two hundred (200) feet to a stake on Crystal Avenue; thence along Crystal Avenue S.
