I, Mrs. L. E. P. Williamson, of the County and State aforesaid

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, Mrs. L. E. P. Williamson, the said, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, Lancaster Mills, a corporation well and truly indebted to in the full and just sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Seven (\$3,527.00) Dollars, to be paid October 1st 1923

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid - annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent. (10%) of the amount due thereon besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

Williamson, the said, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and the bona fide securing the payment thereof to the said Lancaster Mills, according to the terms of the said note, in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, Mrs. L. E. P. Williamson, the said, in hand well and truly paid by Lancaster Mills

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lancaster Mills

all that tract of land in Hartt Township, Greenville County State of South Carolina, on both sides of the Fork Shoals Road, being seven and one-half (7 1/2) miles from Greenville Court House, containing one hundred and one (101) acres, more or less adjoining lands of Mrs. W. M. Williamson, Dr. E. B. Hendrix, Lancaster Mills, R. B. Ashmore, and being more particularly described in a deed of John H. Campbell to Mrs. L. E. P. Williamson, dated January 7, 1910 and recorded in Deed Book 410, page 100, in the office for Greenville County, S. C.
