Dollars, to be paid One year from date

with interest thereon, from Sept 17 1937
computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time not paid and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% of the whole amount
due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

of South Carolina, in Ward one of the City of Greenville, on the
South side of Stall street and described as follows: Beginning
at a pin on the south side of Stall street a distance of
259 feet from the southwest corner of Rutherford and Stall
streets and running thence S 1/2 E. 118 feet, more or less to
a stake thence N. 87 1/4 W. 42 feet and 4 inches to a stake thence
N. 1/3 W. 118 feet more or less, to a stake on Stall street, thence to
line of Stall street S. 87 1/2 E. 42 feet and four inches to the begin-
ning corner and being the western one-third of the property
conveyed by W. W. Burgess to Fannie S. Cary by deed dated
