all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

*Left the City of Greenville at intersection of Hart-  
sell and Maple Avenues, and having a frontage  
on the north side of Maple Avenue of 35 feet and  
running back parallel along Hartsell Avenue  
a depth of 70 feet and known and designated  
as part of lot no. 11 by survey made by G. M. Furman  
also all that other plot of land in the City,  
County and State aforesaid adjoining the above  
described lot: Beginning at pin on east side  
Hartsell Avenue at a point 70 feet north of in-  
tersection of Hartsell and Maple Avenues and  
running thence with east side of Hartsell in  
a northerly direction 70 feet; thence with line  
of lot no. 10 in an easterly direction 35 feet  
to Glenn property; thence with Glenn pro-  
perty and in a line parallel with Hartsell
