WHEREAS,

with interest from date
at the rate of eight per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid semi-annually,
and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further
promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees of said note to be collected by an attorney or through legal pro-
ceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Norman S. Garrison
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me
in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold
and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Almar Bruce Jones
all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

knowing the lot no. 27 on plat of property of J. R. Brown & R. E. Dalton, Engineer, filed May 1923, and having the following courses and distances according to said plat: Beginning at a stake at the intersection of the White Horse and Anderson Roads and running thence with the Anderson Road N. 38-55 E. 334.4 feet to stake, corner of lot no. 24, thence with line of said lot N. 26-30 W. 169.7 feet to iron pin, corner of lot no. 26; thence with line of said lot S. 62-20 W. 281.2 feet to stake in center of White Horse Road, thence with White Horse Road S. 22-25 E. 304.7 feet to the beginning, containing 1.53 acres, more or less.
