of lot No. 76 on plat of property of Estate of J. Rowley Yown, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1928, said lot having in the aggregate the following courses and distances: Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Julien Avenue, corner of lot No. 78, which pin is 360 feet north of Springfield Street, and running thence with line of Lot No. 78 S. 60 W. 188 feet to corner lot 83; thence with line of said lot N. 31-05 W. 110 feet; thence N. 60 E. 188 feet to iron pin on Julien Avenue; thence with Julien Avenue 110 feet to the beginning corner.
