Township, Greenville County, State of *South Carolina*

on the *Antt* *containing forty-seven acres more or*
less according to a survey made June 1917 by R. E.
Dalton, Engineer, being the same fully described in
the deed *delegated by C. L. Jones to the above named*
grantee *day and being the same conveyed to*
C. L. Jones *two deeds as follows: (1) a deed for*
the undivided one-half interest of Louise Carl dated
June 21, 1917 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville
County in Book 20, page 210; (2) Deed for the remaining
undivided one-half interest dated July 7, 1917 made by
