 and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I..... have further
 promised and agreed to pay on demand of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note..... be collected by an attorney or through legal pro-
 ceedings of any kind, reference being hereto had will more fully appear.
 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN THAT I, W. M. McEeler and Lina B. McEeler
 IS SATISFIED THIS 2nd DAY OF October, 1927, At the said J. R. Johnson
 in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
 securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note..... and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me..... less
 in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold
 and released, and by these presents do give, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. R. Johnson
 all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

About three miles west of the city of Greenville
 on the south side of the Parker Road, running,
 from a point near Mariahau Hill to a point
 near Whiningham's store, containing 34.11 acres
 more or less and having the following metes
 and bounds: Beginning at an iron post on the
 south side of Parker Road, S. 1° E. Steff's corner
 and running thence with lines of S. 1° E. Steff
 and J. P. Williams S. 55-55 W. 35.47 chains, more
 or less, to store in line of B. G. Steff; thence
 with this line S. 32-35 E. 9° 51' chains to corner
 of triangle conveyed by H. P. Fair to O. V. Hunter,
 thence with his line S. 82 E. 3.40 chains, thence
 with O. V. Hunter's line N. 55-55 E. 22.03 chains
 to stake on south side of Parker Road, thence
 with Parker Road in a northwesterly direction
 9.70 chains, more or less to the beginning
 being part of the same conveyed to F. B. West
 by F. C. Green Blaster.

Also that other tract of land in Gates
 Township recently added to state, aforesaid, containing
 39.72 acres more or less being the same
 conveyed in two parcels to W. M. McEeler, one
 tract of 34 acres by Jerry C. Caton by deed
 dated November 28th 1908 said recorded in
 book 33 page 348 and the other of 2.72 acres
 conveyed to W. M. McEeler by C. H. Jordan by deed
 dated January 14th 1920 and recorded in book
 56 page 491. Reference is said deed is
 hereby made for a more particular description.
