interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Minnie Hunt her heirs and assigns  
All that certain piece of land in Greenville Township, City of Greenville, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina as follows:  
Beginning at an iron stake 100 feet from  
the South west corner of Naviland Avenue  
(formerly Smith Street) and Nellsid Avenue  
running along said line of Avenue 96.6 feet
