with interest thereon from date semi-annually at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said E.C. Haskell

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, Willie Mae Pinson

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E.C. Haskell, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Ward One of the City of Greenville, on the East side of Robinson Street, between Earle and Croft Streets, and described as follows: Beginning at a pin at the north-east corner of Robinson Street and a 16 foot alley and running thence with said alley S. 85.39 E. one hundred eight feet nine inches to a stake, being the South west corner of lot No. 29; thence with line of lot No. 29, N. 1-41 E. fifty five feet to a stake; thence in a westernly direction in a line parallel with first mentioned line, one hundred eight feet nine inches to an iron pin on Robinson Street; thence with Robinson Street S. 1-41 W. fifty-five feet to the beginning and being the South portion of lot No. 27 of Section "C" of a plat of Stone Land Company recorded in R.M.C. Office in Plat Book "A", pages 337 - 345. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by the said E.C. Haskell by deed of even date and this paper is for the purchase money.
