with interest thereon, from January 1st, 1924 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Emma Prince Harrison

all that certain piece or parcel or tracts of land
situate being and being in the State and County
aforesaid being Highland, Lowndes and Liberty
County South Carolina and being and having the
following described land to wit: Beginning on a
stone in the corner of Section 16, T. 12 N., R. 12 E.,
running S. 44° W. 44' 00" to a large pine tree on the
bank of a large creek, thence S. 25° 20' W. 215' 20"
to a stake in the ground, thence S. 62° 15' W. 77' 00"
to an iron nail, thence S. 52° 30' W. 70' 00" to an iron
nail, thence S. 21° 30' W. 215' 00" to the
beginning on Tiger River and containing 77
