

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, A. H. Taylor of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said A. H. Taylor in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 8th day of November 1923

am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Five hundred & 20/100 (\$500.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 8th day of November A. D. 1923

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that the said A. H. Taylor shall pay or cause to be paid to the said

Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville, S. C. present monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of November 1923, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for the next twelve months, the sum of Thirteen & 22/100 (\$13.22) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the said Five hundred & 20/100 (\$500.00) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan and there have been paid two monthly payments, and shall for the next two months pay the sum of Twelve & 11/100 (\$12.11) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two & 7/100 (\$2.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due; for the next two months the sum of Twelve & 20/100 (\$12.20) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two & 7/100 (\$2.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due; for the next two months pay the sum of Eleven & 33/100 (\$11.33) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and One & 33/100 (\$1.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due; for the next two months pay the sum of Ten & 67/100 (\$10.67) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and Sixty-Seven (67) cents, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Five shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made, the said

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said A. H. Taylor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said A. H. Taylor

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Being in Greenville Township County and State aforesaid near the City limits of Greenville known and designated as lots nos 69 and 70 and fifteen (15) feet of Western side of Lot. No. 71 as shown in sub-division of the Sheron. Carles property known as Oaklawn as per plat made by the Fitzpatrick Terry Company, dated May 6th 1920 and recorded in Plat Book C. at page 273 R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. Being same lots conveyed to me by C. C. Jamison by deed aforesaid date herewith to be recorded. The above described lots are the same lots conveyed to C. C. Jamison by the said A. H. Taylor by deed dated November 25th 1921, recorded in Volume 174 Page 157 R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
