

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, W. B. Iler of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said W. B. Iler in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 7th day of March 1924

and indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Twenty-three Hundred + 40/100 (\$2300.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 7th day of March A. D. 1924, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that I

the said W. B. Iler shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of March 1924, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Thirty-eight + 33/100 (\$38.33) Dollars, (\$23.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Twenty-three (23) Shares of Stock, and Fifteen + 33/100 (\$15.33)

Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Thirty-five + 27/100 (\$35.27) Dollars, (\$23.00) Dollars, being the the regular monthly payment on said stock and Balance + 27/100 (\$12.27) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Thirty-two + 20/100 (\$32.20) Dollars, (\$23.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and None + 20/100 (\$0.20)

Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty-nine + 13/100 (\$29.13) Dollars, (\$23.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Six + 13/100 (\$6.13) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty-six + 07/100 (\$26.07) Dollars, (\$23.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Three + 07/100 (\$3.07) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Twenty-three shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by W. B. Iler to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made of, the said W. B. Iler and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against I the said W. B. Iler in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said W. B. Iler in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said W. B. Iler in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

An Olson street fronting said street 140 feet and having a depth of 170 feet being the Agnew place conveyed to me by two deeds, one from E. Inman Master and others dated March 24th 1919 recorded in Volume 54 page 24 one conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master, April 20th 1920, recorded in Volume 67 page 15, respectively in the R. M. C. office for Greenville, S. C.
