

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, Lillian A. Bull, of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said Lillian A. Bull, in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 11th day of June 1924

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 11th day of June A. D. 1924, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said Lillian A. Bull shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of June 1924, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Fifty-three and 33/100 (\$53.33) Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the Fifty (50) Shares of Stock, and for the next twenty months pay the sum of Seventy-six and 67/100 (\$76.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Fifty (50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and

Twenty-six and 20/100 (\$26.20) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Fifty-three and 33/100 (\$53.33) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and

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Twenty-six and 20/100 (\$26.20) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.) Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said fifty (50) shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made, the said

Lillian A. Bull and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against, the said Lillian A. Bull in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN That the said Lillian A. Bull in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me

the said Lillian A. Bull in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows: Being Lots 157 and 158 of Overbrook, Plat recorded in Plat Book F, page 218, and having the following notes and bounds. Beginning at the intersection of South line of Overbrook Circle with the East line of Jedwood Drive; thence S. 59-55 E. 60 feet; thence S. 76-45 E. with South line of Overbrook Circle 100 feet; thence S. 7-32 E. 43-10 feet to street Railway; thence S. 69-45 W. 75 feet; thence S. 7-55 W. 75 feet; thence S. 89-35 W. 65 feet to Jedwood Drive; thence along East line of Jedwood Drive N. 28-45 E. 155 feet to the beginning, being the same lots conveyed to me by Overbrook Land Company, deed dated April 22nd, 1924, and recorded in Volume 72, page 158, R.M.C.
