Glenn, his heirs and assigns forever, all that lot of land in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, known as Lot No. 22, on a plat of the property of E.G. Glenn, made by C.M. Furman, Jr. March 28th, 1923, said plat having been recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 148.

Beginning on the Laurens Road at the corner of lots No. 21 and 22, and running thence with said Laurens Road N. 55-41 W. 50 feet; thence S. 34-19 W. 175 feet to line of lot No. 29; thence S. 55-41 E. 50 feet; thence N. 34-19 E. 175 feet to the point of beginning on the Laurens Road.
