Office for Greenville County in Vol. XVV, page 425; thence with line of said lot S 57-10 N. 167 feet to a stake; thence S. 80 N. 23 feet to a stake on the right of way of the Southern Railway; thence with right of way of Southern Railway S. 2-30 E. 20 feet to a stake; thence E. 61 feet to a stake; thence N. 63-50 E. 150 feet to a stake on Hampton Avenue; thence with line of said Avenue N. 35-15 N. 55 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. H. Crutshaw by his deed dated July 5th, 1923.
