computed and paid quarterly and charged back to principal
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. D. Neal, his heirs and assigns

All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, being known
and designated as Lot No. 5 of Sans Souci Annex, as shown on plat recorded in the R.I.C.
Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book C, page 29 and having the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake, corner of Perry Road and Taylor Street, and running thence with Taylor
Street N. 42-20 W. 157.5 feet to a stake, corner of Taylor Street and a ten foot alley; thence
with said alley S. 42-40 E. 50 feet to a stake, corner of lots 5 and 6; thence along line of
Lot 6, S. 42-20 E. 157.5 feet to stake, corner of lots 5 and 6 on Perry Road; thence with
