We, Otis Jamison and D.J. Goodwin SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we, the said Otis Jamison and D.J. Goodwin
in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Twenty-five hundred (\$2500.00)
Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of
ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.W. Norwood: All that certain lot of land situate about 3

miles East of the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, on the North side
of the Laurens Road, with the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin at the
intersection of Laurens Road and an unnamed Street and running thence with said Street N.
47.15 E. 200 feet to iron pin; thence N. 42.45 W. 63.6 feet to iron pin at corner of lot
No. 1; thence along joint line of lots 1 and 2 S. 45.15 W. 186.6 feet to an iron pin on
Laurens Road; thence along Laurens Road S. 30.50 E. 65 feet to the beginning corner, being
