grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Carrie E. Mitchell: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of

land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Glassy Mountain Township and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the Glassy Mountain Road and running thence S. 0-30 E. 30.50 chs. to a stake; thence S. 86-30 E. 13.80 chs. to a poplar (dead and down); thence N. 4 E. 17.60 chs. to mouth of branch on creek; thence up the meanderings of said creek 10.21 chs. to a stone on creek; thence up said creek to the center of the Glassy Mountain Road; thence with said Glassy Mountain Road in a westerly direction to the beginning corner, containing 49.49 acres, more or less and being all of Tract #4 on a plat of Carrie E. Mitchell land surveyed by W.P. Marrow, Surveyor Feb. 13th, 1924. This Note and mortgage is given to secure the purchase price of the above described tract of land.
