TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

We, Lillian M. Hudson and M.E. Hudson SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, We, Lillian M. Hudson and M.E. Hudson  
in and by a certain - note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, we are well and truly indebted to  
the Citizens Bank of Taylors, Taylors, S.C.  
in the full and just sum of Ten thousand ninety-nine and 86/100  
Dollars, to be paid On Demand

with interest thereon, from date the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount, evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney of 10% besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,  
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That, We, Lillian M. and M.E. Hudson  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Citizens Bank  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us, the said Lillian M. and M.E. Hudson  
in hand well and truly paid by the said Citizens Bank

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Bank, All those pieces, lots and parcels of land, lying  
and being in the town of Taylors, Chick Springs Township, State and County aforesaid, between the  
National Highway and the Southern Railroad right of way: Beginning at a point on the said  
highway, corner of L.L. Benson lot; thence S. 71-3/4 W. 204 ft. along said Highway; thence S. 30  
E. 285 ft. along the property of W.J. Goudlock to right of way of Sou. Ry.; thence S. 85 E. 165 ft.  
9 ins. along said right of way, corner L.L. Benson lot; thence along said property line of L.L.-  
Benson to place of beginning.

Also, beginning on an iron pin on the edge of said Highway and running thence almost due South  
38 ft. to a stake at the corner of W.P. Raines lots; thence almost due East along the fronts of  
said Raines lots 194 ft. to a stake on the edge of said Highway; thence up said Highway 194 ft.  
to the beginning corner. Said lots purchased from Alfred G. Taylor, Exec. and W.P. Raines.

Also, all that certain parcel, piece or lot of land lying and being in the Town of Greer and in  
the State and County aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on  
an iron pin in the center of a gully 211' from N.W. corner of Cemetery & Mostello Streets and  
runs thence with said gully 79' W. 200 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 4 E. 115 ft. to an iron pin;  
thence S. 79 E. 200 ft. to an iron pin on Mostello Street; thence with Mostello Street N. 4 W.  
106 ft. to the beginning corner; this being all of that lot of land as shown by deed given me by  
I.C. Moon and recorded in office of R.M.C. Greenville County Bk. H. page 481.

Also, all that piece, parcel and tract of land lying and being situated in the County and State  
aforesaid, bounded by lands of Stanley Jones, Emanuel Morris and others, and containing fifty-four  
acres (54) more or less, and also another small tract of land in same County and State, on the  
Ridge Road to Pelham, containing One and one-eighth (1-1/8) acres, more or less, and both of the  
said tracts, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the Ridge  
Road to Pelham Mills, and runs thence S. 16 W. with line of Chas. Morris 25.35 to a stake; thence  
S. 87 E. 25.75 with line of W.R. Hudson to S. Gum; thence N. 17-1/2 W. 11.20 to a stone; thence S.  
75 W. 3.60 to a Maple and stone; thence N. 17 W. 12.78 to a stone; thence N. 13-1/2 E. 5.20 to a  
stone on the said Ridge Road; thence S. 55 W. 7.00 with said road to a stone; thence N. 76-2/3 W.  
2.94 to an iron pin; thence N. 78-1/2 W. 7.85 to an iron pin; thence N. 83-1/2 W. 7.09 to the  
beginning corner and being the tracts of land conveyed to Chas. Morris by E.D. Bighen by deed  
dated Jan. 1st, 1907 recorded in Vol. TTT page 381.

Also, that certain tract, piece and parcel of land, lying and being situated in Butler Town-  
ship, in the State and County aforesaid, containing Twenty-two and one-half acres (22-1/2) more or  
less and bounded by lands of P.H. Jones, R.L. Smith, S.A. Vaughan and others; this being a part  
of the fifty eight (58) acres formerly conveyed to J.R. Freeman and B.F. Morgan by E. Inman, Master  
for Greenville County, the other 35-1/2 acres being sold to P.H. Jones and M.E. Hudson and J.J.-  
Morgan, in deed bearing date of Jan. 2nd, 1920.

Also that tract or parcel of land situate on the East side of Frank Street in the City and County  
of Greenville, South Carolina, and beginning on said street at an iron pin 56 feet from the corner  
of Pinckney and Frank Streets and runs thence with Frank Street S. 57 W. 54 ft. to an iron pin,  
corner of lot of Manie R. Raines; thence with her line S. 34.10 E. 175 ft. to an iron pin on an  
alley; thence with said alley N. 57 E. 14 ft. to an iron pin; thence in a westerly course 12 ft.  
to an iron pin 8 ft. from Manie R. Raines line; thence N. 34.10 W. 28 ft. parallel with line of  
said Raines to an iron pin 8 ft. from her line; thence in a line parallel with Frank Street N. 57 -
