

October 30, 1919, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book 40, at 106, the other one-half interest in said lot having been previously conveyed to F.F. Edwards.

Also, the one-half undivided interest of F.F. Edwards in another tract of land in Laurens County, South Carolina, about one mile South of the Town of Fountain Inn, on the West side of the Greenville- Laurens Road, containing 22 acres, more or less: Beginning at a stone on F.F. Edwards' corner of the Greenville- Laurens public road and running thence S. $21\frac{1}{2}$ E. 13.00 to stone at Mrs. Ella Rogers' corner; thence along line of Mrs. Rogers 13.90 to stone at R.R. Chapman's lands; thence along R.R. Champan's line 13.34 to stone, corner of F.F. Edwards' land; thence N. $69\frac{1}{2}$ E. 13.87 along F.F. Edwards' line to the beginning corner, said tract of land consisting of all the tract of land containing about 12 acres, conveyed to N.H. Owings by the estate of his mother, Mrs. M.E. Owings, and also all that other tract of land containing about 10 acres, conveyed to N.H. Owings by Jerhue Kicklighter both tracts being the same conveyed to F.F. Edwards and Effie Edwards by deed of N.H. Owings dated Jan. 23, 1919, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Laurens County in Book 43, at page 525, reference thereto being made for a full and more definite description of said lands.

Also, all the right, title and interest of F.F. Edwards in and to a certain tract of land in Dial's Township, Laurens County, State of South Carolina, containing 45 acres, more or less, and being the same land conveyed to A.G. Edwards and F.F. Edwards by J.W. Fowler and J.A. Adams on Jan. 2, 1920, by deed which was recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Laurens County in Book 43, at page 520.

Also, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being situate in the East side of North Main Street, in the Town of Fountain Inn, S.C., County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, containing One and one/100 acres, more or less, and known as all of Lot No. 85, conveyed to H.L. Shaw by J.B. Jones, January 3, 1895 and recorded in the office of R.M.C. Greenville County, March 5, 1895, Book D., page 3 (Contains $\frac{3}{4}$ acre more or less).

Also, $\frac{13}{50}$ acre of lot No. 84 conveyed to H.L. Shaw by J.A. Cannon and J.I. West, Jan. 2, 1895, and recorded in office of R.M.C. Greenville County, March 12, 1895, Book D., at page 23, making a total as above (one and $\frac{1}{100}$ acres, more or less). Bounded by lots of D.M. Garrett, J.A. Thomason and Main Street, and being the same conveyed to F.F. Edwards by H.L. Shaw by deed dated December 23rd. 1918, which deed is recorded in office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Book 49, at page 1.
