WHEREAS, I, E. H. Eppes, the said Promisor, in and by my certain Attorney, N. K. Townes, am well and truly indebted to you in writing, of even date with these presents, in the full and just sum of Eight Hundred Fifty (\$850.00) Dollars, to be paid

One (1) year after date 10-10-1940 at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% on the whole amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured by this mortgage) in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, E. H. Eppes, the said Promisor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Attorney, N. K. Townes, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said E. H. Eppes, in hand well and truly paid by the said N. K. Townes, Attorney.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said N. K. Townes, Attorney, his heirs and assigns, All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Oaklawn Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing Thirty-Four & 34/100 (34.34) acres, more or less, and described, as follows, and known as tract No. 1 of the Estate of Morning Eppes, Beginning at a stone corner of Kelly and Jordan land, running thence N. 72 - E. 12.60 to corner; thence with said Kelly's land N. 51-15 E 26.50 to corner in Kelly's line; thence again with Kelly's line N. 61-50 E. 6.83 to corner in line of Tract No. 2 of Morning Eppes' Estate; thence with line of tract No. 2 of said land N. 46-15 W. 4.80 to corner in line of tract No. 2; thence S. 69 W. 71-30 W. 27-48 to corner of Estelle Jordan land; thence with line of Jordan's land S. 15-40 W. 16.00 to the beginning corner, and being the same land conveyed to me by Fannie C. Scott, Probate Judge, for Greenville County by deed dated day of 1926, to be recorded.
