with interest thereon, from *the date hereof* at the rate of *5* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent.*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,  
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said *R. M. Dacres*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said *R. M. Dacres* - All those two certain pieces, parcels or lots of

land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County and Township  
of Greenville, near Verner Springs, on Heyward Street, and being known and designated  
as Lots 114 and 115 on a plat recorded in Plat Book A, page 177, said lots having a  
frontage of 50 feet each on Heyward Street, and a depth of 100 feet; these being the same  
lots of land conveyed to me by J.H. Orr by his deed dated January 1920, and recorded in  
Office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Vol. 63, page 182.
