All that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate in the State and County aforesaid on branch waters of Rocky Creek of Enoree River, six miles east of the City of Greenville, containing one hundred (100) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone 3x4, N.C. 3x0, thence S. 78 E. 13.00 to a stone 3x0; thence N. 12 E. 7.42 to a stake 3x4; thence S. 87 E. 24.20 to a stone 3x4; thence N. 14 1/4 E. 20.62 to a Sweet gum; 3x4; thence N. 67 1/2 E. 8.60 to an ash 3x4; thence N. 13 E. 2.00 to a stone 3x0; thence N. 54 W. 15.00 to a stone 3x0; thence S. 67 1/2 W. 16.30 to a Pine 3x0; thence S 62 1/2 W. 11.25 to a small N. C. 3x0; thence S 34 1/2 W. 8.00 to a P. C. 3x0; thence S. 2.00 to a N. C. 3x0 on the branch; thence down the meanders thereof to the beginning corner; on west side of branch and north of road.
