designated as Lot No. 17, Block "U" of the Riverside Land Company according to a plat
recorded in Plat Book "A", page 323, having a frontage of 50 feet on Highlawn Avenue and
a depth of 125 feet. Being the same lot conveyed to me by A.G. Bullock by deed dated Dec.
17, 1919 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 57, page 322.

Also, all that other certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in Greenville County,
South Carolina, adjoining the above described lot and known and designated as Lot No. 18,
Block "U" of the said Riverside Land Company according to the plat recorded in Plat Book
"A", page 323, said lot having a frontage of 50 feet and a depth of 125 feet. Being the
same lot conveyed to me by Mary E. Stiller by deed dated Jan. 9, 1920, and recorded in the
R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 56, page 457.

Also all that certain piece, parcel or strip of land situate in the County and State
aforesaid, adjoining lot No. 18 hereinabove described, known and designated as a portion of
