a part of the tract of land of A. Abercrombie (deceased). Beginning at a stone on T.C. Woods
line and running thence N. 30-15 E. 26.23 chains to stone at fork of road; thence along the
road N. 24-00 W. 14.81 chains to bend in road; thence N. 46-30 W. 8.22 chains to stake;
