until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be in arrears, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney fee of ten dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection of a said debt, or any part thereof be collected by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NO KNOWINGLY MEN, that before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.A. Hopkins: All that tract or lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, Oaklawn Township, on the Cedar Falls Road and Reedy River, containing Two hundred fifty acres, more or less, being the same tract of land devised to me in the eighth clause of the Will of my father F.M. Austin, and being the same tract of land conveyed to F.M. Austin by J.W. Harrison by deed dated May 11th, 1875, recorded in office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Vol. GG, page 395.
