in hand well and truly paid by the said Citizens Bank of Taylors

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Bank of Taylors, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of

land situated in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina and
in the Town of Taylors, and being known and designated as Lot No. 26 on a subdivision of Lot
No. 2, property of W.M. Shockley, deceased, as shown by subdivision and plat of same made by
Thos T. Linder, Nov. 10th, 1921, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for the County and State afore-
said, in Plat Book F., page 20. This lot contains 2.92 acres, and is more particular described
as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Lot No. 25, at or near the public road, running thence
along the line of lot No. 25, N. 77 W. 5.70 to a pine; thence S. 2-1/2 E. 5.00 to a stake at
corner of Lot No. 27; thence S. 60-1/2 E. 5.45; thence N. 6-1/2 E. 6.35 to the beginning corner.
Reference is hereby craved to the plat above referred to for a more particular description of
said Lot.

Also, all that piece of lot of land situated, lying and being in the said State and County,
Chick Springs Township on Morrow-Bone Creek branch waters of Enoree River, adjoining lands of
Alfred Taylor, W.M. Shockley and J.F. Freeman, and having the following metes and bounds, Viz:
Beginning on a stone, the corner of the said W.M. Shockley land, and running thence N. 5-3/4
E. 6.66 chains to the mouth of a ditch on the Morrowbone creek, thence down the said creek as a
line S. 72-1/4 E. 3.93 chains to the said Alfred Taylors line; thence S. 28-1/2 W. 6.27 chains to an
iron pin in the edge of the road; thence N. 86 W. 1.32 chains to the beginning corner, containing
one and two-thirds (1-2/3) acres, more or less.

Also, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in said State and County,
on the Morrowbone Creek, a branch of the Enoree River in Chick Springs Township, and more
particularly described as follows:-

Beginning at an iron pin, Riley Smith's corner, and runs thence N. 87.30 W. 95 to a stake on
the east side of the road, Riley Smith's corner; thence N. 28.15 E. 229 to a stake in Morrowbone
Creek; thence down and with the creek N. 89 E. 100 to a stake; thence S. 28.15 W. 230 to the
beginning, containing one half acre, more or less.
