All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the west side of Summer St. being in the fifth ward of said City, and with the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Summer Street 151 feet and 9 inches from the southwest corner of Pebleton and Summer Streets and running thence N. 72.42 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 17.18 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 72.42 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on Summer Street; then with said Street N. 17.18 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner, as shown by plat made by Will D. Nevee, Surveyor dated May 20th, 1915, being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. O. Grove by deed dated March 29th, 1924, and recorded in the R. M. C.
