WHEREAS, I, the said J. Albert Bramlett

in and by me certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Thirteen hundred no/100 Dollars,

to be paid on or before the date when the Series of the Instalment

Stock of the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION shall reach maturity, with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, on or before Saturday night of each and every week, until paid in full; and if I

fail to pay said interest or to comply in all respects with the By-Laws of said association, for the space of thirty days, then said debt shall become immediately due and payable, together with all interest, fines and expenses, and all amounts advanced by the said Association on the within described property, by way of taxes or insurance, the same to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as part thereof, together with an attorney's fee of ten per cent. if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage, as provided in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

in hand well and truly paid by the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said AMERICAN BUILDING

AND LOAN ASSOCIATION All that lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County,

South Carolina, in Ward One, City of Greenville, on the north side of Harvley Street, known as Lot No. 3-A according to a plat of said property by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, March 1921, recorded in Plat Book E, page 214, and having the following metes and bounds: beginning at a point on the North side of Harvley Street at corner of lot No. 2 which point is 150 feet from Rutherford Street and running thence along Harvley Street S. 84-4 E. 50 feet to iron pin; thence N. 1-12 E. 108.5 feet to iron pin; thence N. 87-5 W. 50 feet to iron pin; thence S. 1-12 W. 109.4 feet, more or less, to beginning, being the same conveyed to J. Albert Bramlett by E.M. Gillespie by deed dated March 31, 1924, recorded in Book 82, page 479.
